TeleHealth Research and Innovation for VEterans with Cancer (THRIVE) is an NIH-funded research center on the intersection of teleoncology and social determinants of health (SDoH). Our overarching goal is to help VA understand how SDoH affect delivery of telehealth care for cancer. We aim to achieve this by conducting a pragmatic trial evaluation of the VA National TeleOncology Program (NTOP), funding pilot projects in topics above, training the next generation of oncology researchers in VC and health equity, and creating a high-functioning network to facilitate further research.
