### **Funding Opportunity From the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute (NHLBI)**

[This Notice of Special Interest \(NOSI\)](#) aims to support research that generates evidence on the real-world effectiveness of telehealth collaboration among healthcare providers for consultation, second opinions, and other purposes, referred to as provider-to-provider telehealth (PPT). PPT offers remote access to critical health expertise that might not exist locally in certain communities. The funding has co-participation of the National Cancer Institute (NCI) and the Office of Disease Prevention (ODP), and is inspired by the gaps and opportunities identified by the [2022 Federal Partners Meeting Report](#), and the NIH's "[Improving Rural Health Through Telehealth-Guided Provider-to-Provider Communication](#)" Workshop.

Research supported by this NOSI is expected to:

1. Contribute to the advancement of health equity and access to care in rural communities through implementation research focused on telehealth-guided provider-to-provider communication;

## Upcoming Study:

### ***Assessing Collaborative Research Networks to Enhance Research Value***

To better understand what individual and environmental factors contribute to successful collaborative research, Dr. Elizabeth Stevens at NYU Langone Health is conducting a research study that will collect information about our consortium's members and their collaboration networks.

The study will last approximately 5 years and involve several parts including a baseline survey, the possibility of a one-time 60-minute interview, and four follow-up surveys. The surveys will ask about your background, personality, perceptions of collaborative research, research productivity, and collaboration network. 2. Stimulate evidence-based interventional and observational research to investigate the real-world effectiveness of provider-to-provider telehealth in managing the health of rural populations while observing, gathering, and assessing information on implementation;
3. In settings where evidence of clinical effectiveness of PPT is robust, develop and test implementation strategies while observing and gathering information on the intervention's impact on relevant outcomes.

**REMOTE position open – Research Coordinator**

The Bedford CHOIR group is seeking a full-time Research Coordinator to assist Principal Investigator Dr. Varsha Vimalananda with a remote patient monitoring (RPM) study of a novel FDA-approved device to predict cardiopulmonary decompensation among patients previously hospitalized with COVID-19. The Research Coordinator will work with the Project Manager and other team members to help administer study activities, recruit and track research participants, manage the study database, and collect qualitative and closed-ended survey data from participants. **Final Reminder: TeleHealth Research and Innovation for Veterans with Cancer (THRIVE) Associate Investigator Program RFA**

Just under a week remains to submit an application for the THRIVE Associate Investigator Program RFA. This training program includes ~25k in FY24 funding for early career investigators (pre-major award such as CDA, R01, K) and an extensive mentorship and foundational curriculum in areas of teleoncology and health equity research. Applications are due June 5<sup>th</sup> at 11:59 PM EST and are relatively brief and straightforward – please see the RFA PDF attached to the May Newsletter email for details. Applicants with a mentor with funded research at the VA will be preferred. For those who have advanced beyond this point in your careers, please consider forwarding to mentees or junior researchers to whom the AIP might be of interest!
