Clinician Experiences with VA's Electronic Health Record Modernization: Initial Findings from the EMPIRIC QUERI Evaluation

The EMPIRIC QUERI is a partnered evaluation initiative focused on understanding frontline clinician and staff experiences with VA's electronic health record modernization (EHRM). We aim to identify best practices that can improve future EHRM efforts. In this Cyberseminar, co-leads Drs. Rinne and Sayre will describe initial EMPIRIC findings from the mixed-methods evaluation at the Mann-Grandstaff VA Medical Center in Spokane, WA. Dr. Matthews will reflect on evaluation findings, note important contextual factors impacting initial EHRM experiences, and discuss how evaluation findings relate to future EHRM efforts.

Gemmae M. Fix, PhD is an Applied Medical Anthropologist and Research Health Scientist at the Center for Healthcare Organization and Implementation Research (CHOIR), located in Bedford, MA. Dr. Fix has expertise in qualitative, ethnographic and participatory research methods. She serves as the Qualitative Methods Lead with the PROVEN Hub Data and Methods Core where she provides expert technical and methodological consultation. Dr. Fix, along with co-PI Dr. Jessica Davila, co-leads Enhancing PROVEN's Understanding of the Veteran Experience during the Cerner Transition (PROVEN VET), which engages Veteran stakeholders to understand Veterans' experiences of Cerner implementation.
