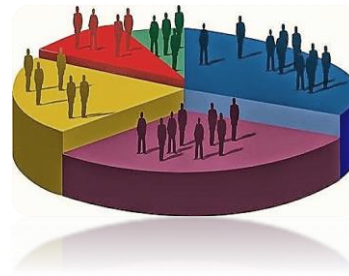

# VINCI DATA

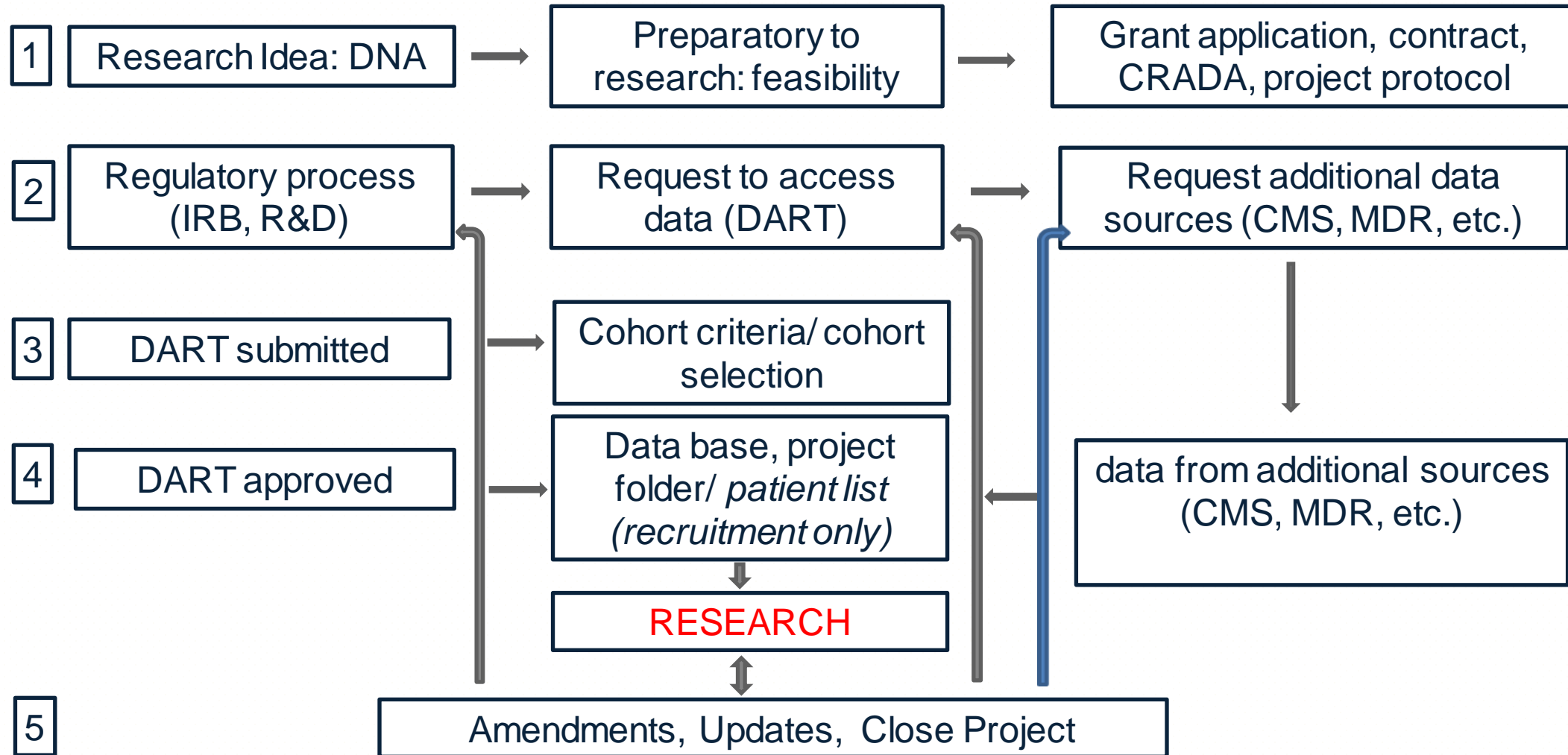
- ✓ VINCI data base has data on more than 26 million patients receiving care at over 1,400 medical centers (inpatient), outpatient clinics, nursing homes, and non-VA medical centers
- ✓ Most data originates from the extensively used the VA electronic medical record systems (Veterans Health Information Systems and Technology Architecture (VistA) and Millennium HER) and from other data sources
- ✓ SQL (language designed to store, extract data) is using to pull variables of interest from data sources for the cohort
- ✓ Data is not available in VINCI, but can be incorporated in project data base: cause of death (MDR), Medicaid/Medicare data (CMS), etc.
- ✓ Data is not available in VINCI: images
- ✓ Data is available only in text: pathology report, radiology report, medical providers notes, etc. (TIU notes, CPRS, CAPRI/JLV)

# Preparatory to research \_ DNA

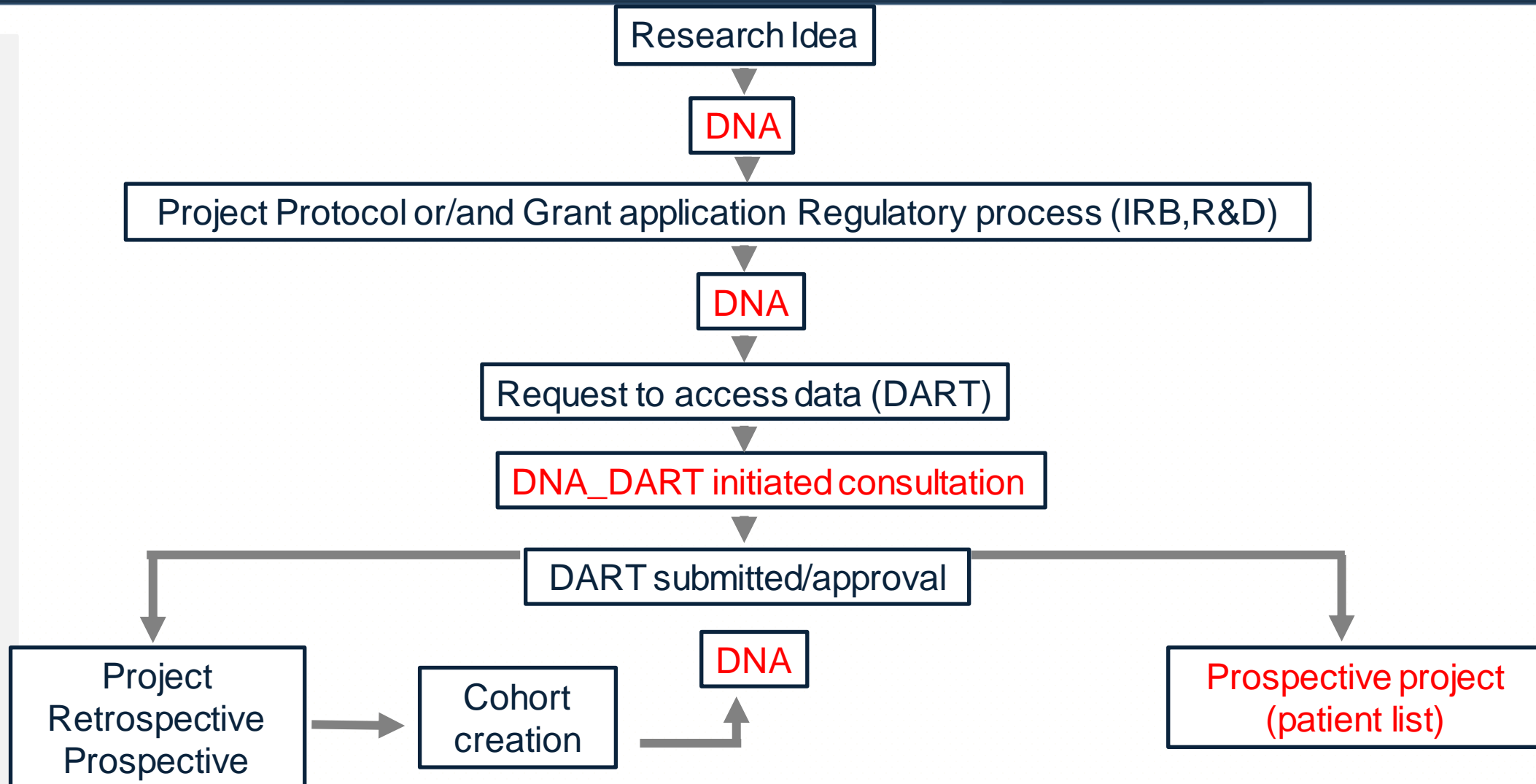
VINCI Services supports VA research by assisting customers with **Data Needs questions (DNA)** relating to the VA Corporate Data Warehouse (CDW) and other VA data sources.

These questions range from

- ✓ data availability
- ✓ data location
- ✓ data definitions
- ✓ Language for the proposal/ IRB protocol preparation,
- ✓ assistance with completing the DART application
- ✓ assistance with completing DART forms including CDW-domain checklist,
- ✓ Other questions.

# Preparatory to Research \_ Feasibility

- Feasibilities provide aggregate counts for researchers during **the preparatory-to-research phase**. The deliverables result in summarized counts to assist in grant and IRB applications.
- Feasibilities help to understand **cohort size and structure**
- Feasibilities help to understand **impact of each criteria to cohort size and structure**
- **No regulatory documents** are required
- Feasibilities result **cannot** be used for any publication
- Can be conducted by VINCI Services team (no DART)
- Request feasibility count at [vinci@va.gov](mailto:vinci@va.gov)

# Preparatory to Research \_ Feasibility

## Inclusion/exclusion criteria

- Location (nationwide or some specific location)
- Time frame
- Age/gender/other limitation
- Diagnosis (ICD9\*/10 codes (\*VA uses ICD10 codes since October 2015. If time frame more than 7 years, please, provide both))
- Procedures (CPT codes or/and ICD-PC)
- Lab test (topography, units, range)
- Medications (list of all generic and brand names, strength and route of administration)

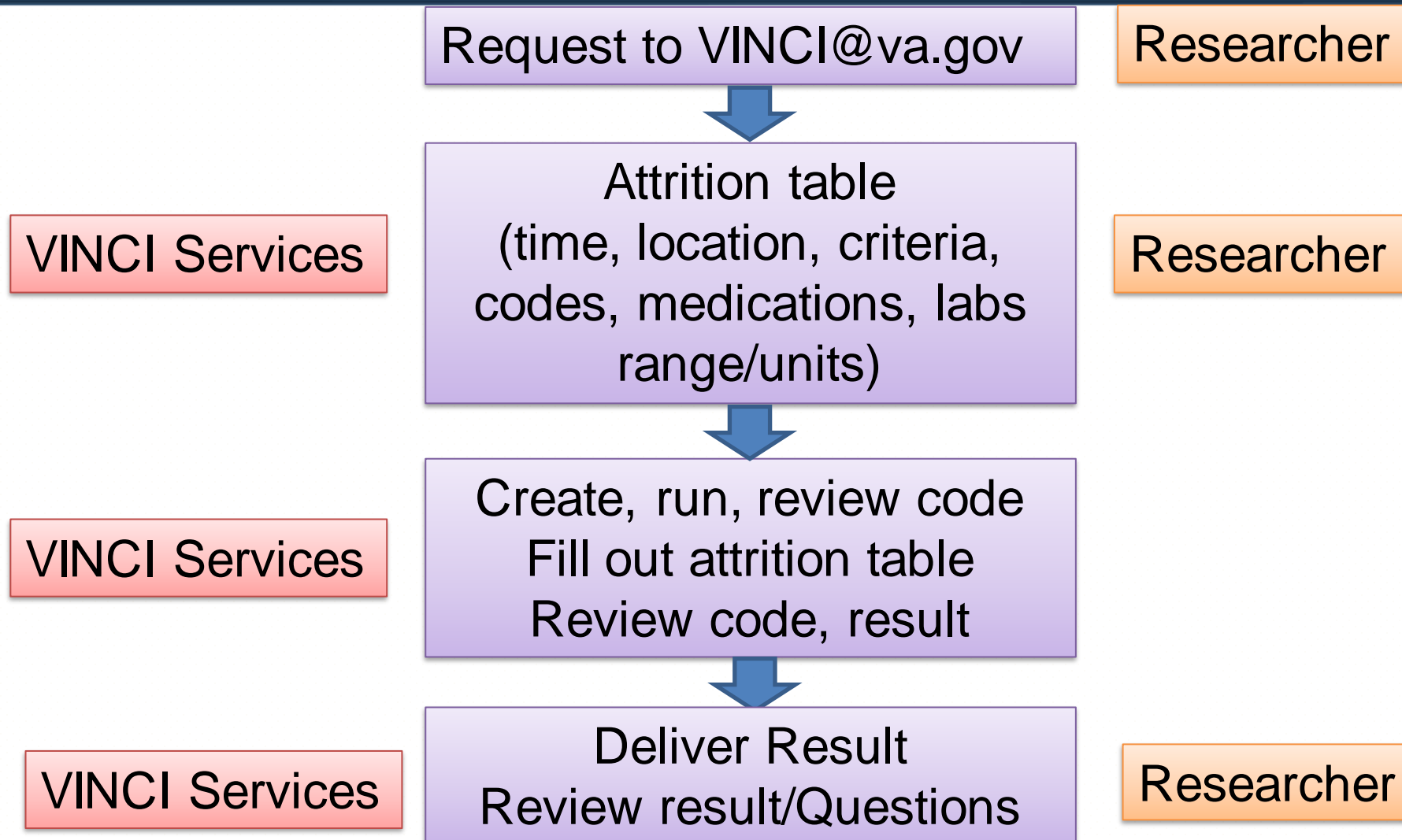

### Overview

The Data Access Request Tracker (DART) Preparatory to Research (PTR) Request Process is for requesting permission to access VHA data with protected health information (PHI) when preparing a research funding application or protocol as allowed by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) Privacy Rule (45 CFR 164.512). This process is only for [PTR activities](#). Pilot studies are not considered PTR activity. The [Research Access](#) page provides information on requesting data for these studies.

### Which data sources can I request?

Many, but not all data sources and tools can be requested through DART for PTR. Here is a list of those that are available for request. Select a data source for a description of its contents and tips for requesting access.



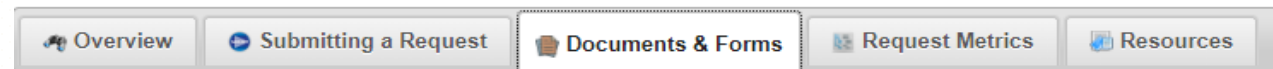

### Documents & Forms

DART will generate a list of documents and forms that you are required to submit. Here is a list of documents and forms you may need. Note: Institutional Review Board (IRB) approval and waivers of HIPPA authorization are not required for PTR access to PHI data.

##### **How to download and view forms.**

- Right click on the link to a form in the table below.
- Select "Save link as..." and save form locally.
- Open PDF forms in Acrobat Reader DC or Adobe Acrobat DC and select "Enable all features" to view content and fill out form.

# Preparatory to Research: IRB/ R&D

## Required Information in Project Protocol



- VINCI description for IRB [IRB Study How-To \(va.gov\)](http://va.gov)
  - 3. \*\*As part of your IRB package you are required to state where data will be stored for analysis. If you are planning to use VINCI for data storage and analysis we provide the following environment and security descriptions for use with IRB packages.

    - [VINCI Information Security Description](#)
- Real SSN/ Scrambled SSN should be requested (CAPRI/JLV, IVC data, USVETS, non-VINCI data sources)
- Storage location ([VINCI](#), Local Server, other)

- If targeted population using 7332 diagnosis (drug abuse, alcohol abuse, HIV, sickle cell anemia) the following statement should be included in IRB Protocol & HIPAA: The purpose of the data is to conduct scientific research and that no personnel involved in the study may identify, directly or indirectly, any individual patient or subject in any report of such research or otherwise disclose patient or subject identities in any manner. # Preparatory to Research: IRB/ R&D



## Required Information in Project Protocol

- If project will need **CAPRI/JLV access**, it should be described in the protocol/IRB protocol and HIPAA Waiver (“Access to patients records on national level will be conducting using CAPRI/JVL applications”)
- If project required cause of death analysis using **MDR data**, it should be described in IRB protocol in study procedure section [Mortality Data \(va.gov\)](#)
- If project required **Medicaid /Medicare analysis using CMS data**, it should be described in IRB protocol in study procedure section [VA/CMS Home](#)
- Inclusion/ exclusion criteria
- Waiver of HIPAA Authorization

# Preparatory to Research: IRB/ R&D

## Inclusion/exclusion criteria

### Ethics Principles for Access to and Use of Veteran Data

- Principle 7: All parties are obligated to ensure data security, quality and integrity of Veteran data.

All parties who send, receive, or use Veteran data must ensure data security, quality and integrity. In other words, that the data remain secure; accurate; complete; and representative of the data quality, meaning, and integrity when it was received or accessed from VA. **Access to data should be limited to the minimum amount needed to accomplish the stated purpose**, and should be terminated when no longer required. Data that are not necessary to accomplish the purpose for which it was obtained should not be retained longer than legally required. Transparency about breaches in data security, quality or integrity is also essential to promote trust and minimize impacts to Veterans.

**Documents & Forms**

- IRB Approved Sample Informed Consent & HIPAA Authorization - *required if signed informed consent forms or HIPAA authorizations will be collected for any portion of the study.*
- IRB Approved [Waiver of HIPAA Authorization](#) - *required if a Waiver of HIPAA Authorization is required for any portion of the study.*

The use or disclosure of PHI involves no more than a minimal risk to the privacy of individuals based on the presence of the following elements:

1. An adequate plan to protect the identifiers from improper use and disclosure.
2. An adequate plan to destroy the identifiers at the earliest opportunity consistent with conduct of research, unless there is a health or research justification for retaining the identifiers or such retention is otherwise required by law (e.g., to satisfy records retention requirements).
3. Adequate written assurances that the PHI will not be reused or disclosed except as required by law, for authorized oversight of the research study, or for other research for which the use or disclosure of PHI would be permitted by the HIPAA Privacy Rule.

Must be signed by the Chair or other designated voting member and include the requirements of the IRB identification, date of waiver approval and review procedure used (convened or expedited).

# Preparatory to Research \_ Team

Preparatory to research/ Research project: VINCI provides data in **SQL format** thus studies will need their own SQL analyst / data manager to extract, manipulate, and analyze their data. VINCI will not do this for you.



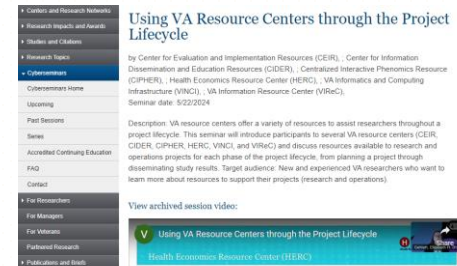

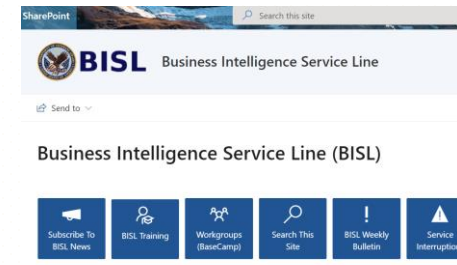
